

45TH ANNIVERSARY MEET SECURITY - PARKING

The 2006 45th Anniversary Meet at the Doubletree Hotel host facility and property will be well covered by the hotel security staff and by our own VCCA members under the supervision of Larry Jamaitis & Bob Emerson. Each VCCA member serving on the security/parking team will be identified by both the regular VCCA Name Badge and a special Security Badge. No other local hotel facilities or parking areas will be covered by the VCCA Security/Parking Team.

Upon your arrival at the host Doubletree Hotel for your stay or to register for the national meet, we would encourage all VCCA members to adhere to the following rules because existing parking is extremely limited.

1. Please park all show vehicles (host hotel guests only) in the front entrance (South) parking area.
2. Please park all regular vehicles (host hotel guests only) in the back (North) parking area.
3. Please do not bring your tow vehicles with trailers to the host hotel site. Show vehicle trailers will not be allowed to park, unload or remain at the hotel site. A storage/parking area will be available offsite and this will be addressed in a future issue of the G&D.
4. Tow vehicles (used as a daily driver by host hotel guest only) will be able to park in the back (North) grass parking area, as space is available.
5. There is a small area in the extreme southern end of the front parking area that is reserved for the swap meet and please do not park there.
6. The show vehicle field-check area will also be setup at this hotel facility along the access road to the

parking lot and again please do not park in this space until the car show has been completed on Wednesday (7/5/06).

7. All host hotel staff will be parking in area adjacent to eastside of the hotel and access driveway to (North) back parking area.
8. All daily-visiting vehicles must park in the North parking area or on its adjacent grass lawn space.
9. Please display special parking passes provided in your registration package within your vehicle's front window at all times.

While at the national meet, all attendees should wear their VCCA Name Badges to gain access to all the VCCA sponsored events, including the various Driving Tours, Social Hours, Banquets, Swap Meet, Chevy Store, Car Show and reserved parking area for all vintage Chevrolet show & display cars.

The Security personnel are there for your protection and assistance. Be cooperative and courteous. Remember that they are doing their job and may not know you. Should an incident or problem happen, please bring it to the attention of someone in charge, so the proper personnel may act upon it quickly, quietly and effectively. GENERAL MEET INFORMATION

The 45th Anniversary Meet will feature seminars, judging school, fashion and craft awards, national car show judging, tours, swap meet, ladies luncheon and awards banquet. There will be optional tours and plenty to keep you busy throughout the week.

The meet officially starts on Monday, July 3, 2006, but THERE WILL BE EARLY-BIRD REGISTRATION CHECK-IN, along with Field Entrance Check, and Photo Shoot on Sunday from 1 PM till 6 PM.

Pictures and Field Check will take place on Sunday and Monday only. ALL VEHICLES REGISTERED FOR THE MEET WILL HAVE THEIR PICTURE TAKEN FOR THE G&D, WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE BEING JUDGED. Monday can also be used to prepare vehicles for judging.

FIELD ENTRANCE CHECK WILL BE REQUIRED OF ALL VEHICLES AND MUST BE COMPLETED MONDAY PRIOR TO 6 PM. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE REQUIRED AND WILL BE CHECKED AT THIS TIME. Fire extinguisher must be in vehicle at all times.

Monday night a welcome reception will be held at the DoubleTree Hotel. The 2006 Anniversary Committee and the City of Grand Junction welcome you to Western Colorado. As the first official event it will be an opportunity to meet and greet fellow VCCA members in a casual atmosphere. Light snacks will be provided, and members are encouraged to meet people from across the USA as well as several international members. It will also be an opportunity to recognize the fellow members who have worked to make the VCCA 45th Anniversary a rousing success.

Tuesday we will hold competition for Crafts, Model Cars, Displays and Fashion with awards being presented. The whole family is invited to participate and age categories will be available. A separate form will be published for: Crafts, Model Cars, Display and Fashions. Look for it in next month's G&D.

Wednesday will be Class Judging Day. ALL CARS, WHETHER JUDGED OR NOT MUST BE ON THE FIELD PRIOR TO 10 AM. ENTRY TO THE FIELD WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AFTER 10 AM. The Judging will take place at Lincoln Park. All meet registered vehicles will be on display, whether judged or not and must have a working fire extinguisher. Classes for judging will be by year and most years judged separately.

Wednesday evening plan to attend the Cross Orchard Cowboy Dinner located a few miles from the headquarters DoubleTree hotel. The historic Cross Orchard was once part of one of the largest apple orchards in Colorado. The historic barn/packing shed and bunkhouse area, both listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is the site of the dinner. The meal will be a modern adaptation of a western trail dinner with a choice of beef or chicken with appropriate side dishes. In addition to the meal, the evening will feature docents demonstrating and explaining the life ways and agricultural traditions on the early 20th Century. The facility, a part of the Museum of Western Colorado, features ancillary exhibits including the Uintah Railway, the Corn Collection of antique road building equipment and the Swanson agricultural exhibit. It will prove to be an enjoyable evening for young and old.

Thursday, will be the Official Plaque Tour and will include lunch and plaque. You will need to choose from one of two tours. Grand Mesa is a higher elevation tour (10,500) and Vega Lake elevation is around (8,000). We will be using the same caterer for both tours so the price will be the same. (Don't forget your passport.)

Friday you can tour on your own. The ladies Luncheon will be held in the afternoon and the Awards Banquet that evening will top off a fun filled week.

Note: There will be no parking or unloading of trailers at the DoubleTree hotel, all trailers are to be stored at designated areas. Motor homes are also NOT allowed in the Hotel Parking lot – please make reservations at RV park.

Registrations will NOT be accepted at the meet or later than May 26, 2006.
